Mayor Cameron Manwaring - Update on Stoltenberg Lane -

Mayor Manwaring presented an update. Bonneville County has provided us with an email recommending that we go out to bid for this project. The county does not believe they can support a project of this size. The mayor has discussed this with the city attorney. Mayor also talked with the Bonneville County Commissioner regarding the relationship between the City and the County. The city would like to see this project progress. The city could go out and get bids from a private company. The City Council will need to evaluate the options and determine the path forward. Getting input from Bonneville County Sheriff and the Fire Department regarding the issues with the current condition of the road. The County Commissioner recommended that the City of Swan Valley attend a future meeting with the County Commissioners and Road & Bridge.



Stacy Crnkovich - The Quick Claim deed of the road seems to be concerning.
