

Update and Presentation from SilverStar on infrastructure plans -

Jason Nelson & McKay Porter presented an overview of the path forward for Silver Star in Swan Valley. They provided a slide presentation. The fiber build out is funded through Federal Grants. This build must be completed by 2028.

Mayor Cameron Manwaring - Update on Stoltenberg Lane -

Mayor Manwaring met with the County Commissioner and the Bonneville Road & Bridge on improvement of the road. The quick claim deed will allow the city to get additional funds from the state. We received letters of support from the fire department and sheriff's office on the improvement to the road. The end result is the county will support the road work on Stoltenberg Lane. The county will send out people to reassess the work and the County Commissioner sounded positive about a shared responsibility for the cost. We should have more information next month. Future meeting to help gain a better understanding on road responsibility. Overall very positive.
