Cost of Fireworks - City of Irwin - Kelly Palmer

- Kelly asked to keep the cost of the fireworks within 16,000, - have the cities split the cost $\frac{1}{2}$ and $\frac{1}{2}$ - if any other donations come in they will subtract additional donations from the 16,000 amount and split the remaining cost $\frac{1}{2}$ & $\frac{1}{2}$ with maximum donation up to 5,500.

- Was held in the past - had Swan Valley kids that were already part of rodeo, they seeked outside sponsors in the past - currently no outside sponsors right now for this year
- Kery - recommend talk to contractors in the area for sponsorships
- Pauline - have sold banner space on bucking chutes in the past - will seek that out again this year.
- Mayor - Anything else you can add that more kids can participate in - gain more interest? - response - maybe catch a calf but probably too short of notice this year to figure something out, but definitely for the future.
- Rodeo has been part of the valley for a long time - would like to bring it back long term
- City Council - Don't think the cities can always support it long term - happy to support and help get it started again - recommend seeking outside help to keep it going for the future.
- Kery - would like them to come back next month with report on what they have already organized
- Audi - working on a community heritage in the valley
- Resort city tax - there are specifications on how the city can use these funds
- Kelly - once word is out he thinks more donations will come around to help

Budget - council recommends allocating funds more specifically



Public Comment
