OTHER CITY BUSINESS

Municipal Non-Property Sales Tax

- Ordinance 89 renewal coming due
- Resolution - needs to be voted on and sent to county to be put on the ballot, we will be voting on it at the next meeting
- Add some verbiage to the ballot stating that we are not changing anything, everything is staying the same just continuing what is already in place, not raising any tax fees
- Bridges are complete, let's state what other improvements can be done with the sales tax and that will benefit the community ie: park improvements
- Send a draft copy of the resolution off to the council ahead of time for review

Next Steps and assignments for City Park sign

- Present picture of sign ideas - one with metal frame one with wood frame
- The City can receive no more than 5,000 as a donation and give a tax write off - everything above needs an appraisal - Labor tricky - materials very easily tax deductible
- Both signs look good - biggest concern with wood frame is sprinklers deteriorating wood posts - lean towards metal posts - want enough room

- underneath the sign to hang banners, something permanent for hanging banners underneath - recommend solar lights for lighting (more cost effective)
- Look at a little better place for locating the sign (not covered by trees), more visible
- City responsible for cost of materials and install if everyone else who came forward offers their time/labor/expertise.

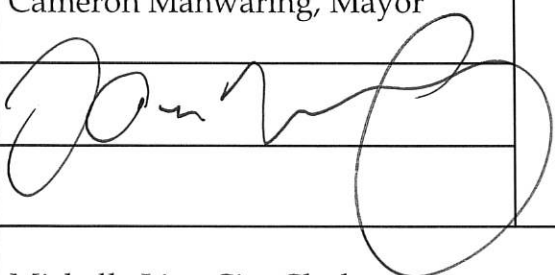
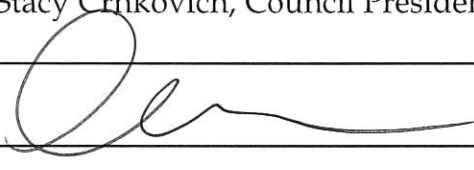
PUBLIC COMMENT
